In youth basketball, Liberty has started their season and are doing a good job. They are learning a varsity play and are learning tarheel.

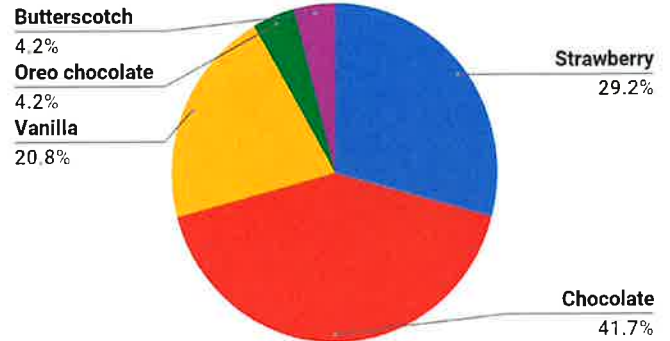
Seattle played the vikings in football, and the Seahawks beat them 37-30!
