

How to do a Reference Page

- ❖ Start your References on a new separate page.
- ❖ References are always listed in alphabetical order, are double-spaced, and have a hanging indentation. Indent after 1st line.
- ❖ If there is no author, the reference citation starts with the first word of the article title.
- ❖ While you are researching, remember to write down (document) the source and the page number the information has come from.
- ❖ Remember to cite your sources within your writing (Zagyva, 2017, p. 199).
- ❖ Citing Sources: If you use a worldbookonline article, use APA citation provided.

Book – Author Last Name, First Initial. (Date of publication). *Title of book*.

City of Publication: Publisher.

Magazine Article – Author Last name, First Initial. (Date of publication). Title of article. *Title of magazine/journal/newspaper, Volume (Issue), pages used.*

Encyclopedia – Author Last name, First Initial. (Year of publication). Article title. In *Encyclopedia Name. (Volume #, pages used). City of Publication: Publisher.*

Website – Author. (Date of publication). Title of page. Retrieved from web address

Videotape – Producer. (Publication date) Video title. Retrieved from web address

Interview – Interviewee's Last Name, First Initial. (Year, Month date). Interview type such as: e-mail, phone, personal interview.
