Also, Liberty baseball has started their fall season and are doing well.

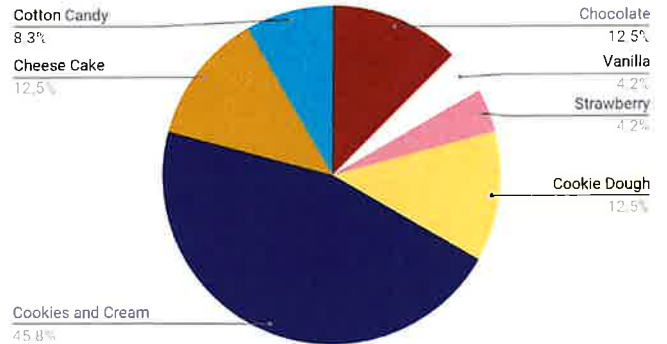
Basketball is starting this winter, The Blazers have signed Damian Lillard a \$196 million contract, so he earns roughly \$70 million a year.
